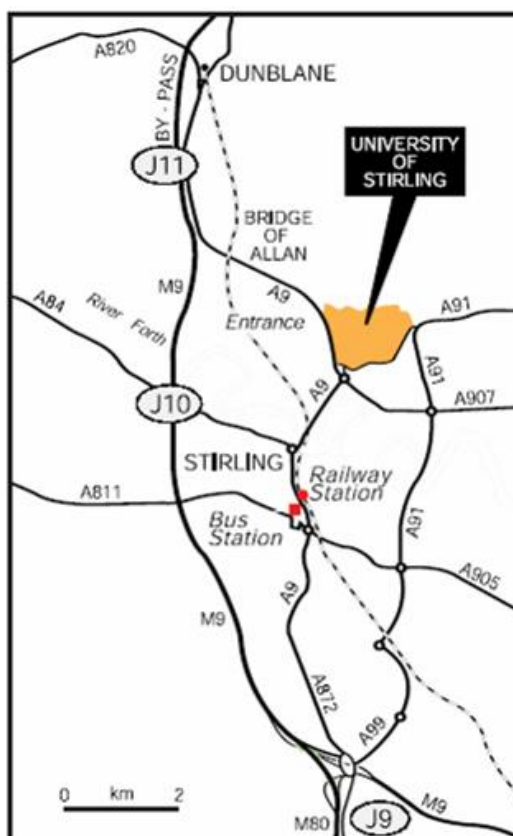

From the North A9 via Perth and Bridge of Allan
From the East A91 from St Andrews A8, M9 from Edinburgh
From the South M74, M73, A80, M80, M9
From the West M8, A80, M80, M9 from Glasgow
