



<b>4. First aid measures:</b>	<i>Eyes:</i> Wash immediately with plenty of water (for at least 15 minutes) and maintain the eyelids open. In case of persistent irritation, consult an ophthalmologist. <i>Skin:</i> Remove soiled clothing. Wash skin with water <i>Inhalation:</i> Place the patient in the open air. If breathing is difficult, call a physician. <i>Ingestion:</i> Rinse mouth with water. Contact the closest Anti-Poison Centre.
