



6. Accidental release measures:	<i>Spillage:</i> Transfer to a container and arrange removal by special disposal.

8. Exposure controls/personal protection	Wear suitable gloves. Persons of known hypersensitivity to penicillins should not handle. Avoid creating dust, inhalation and exposure to skin and eyes.
